FROM THE DESK OF SUPERINTENDENT JOHN DENNEY...

As the new school year quickly approaches, we are working to fine tune how we have traditionally opened a new school year. The 2020-2021 school year will easily be a year unlike anything any of us have ever experienced before. This year will bring technology to the forefront and create opportunities for innovation for both the students and the teachers. We are excited to open our doors for students again!

Our Board of Education officially approved our COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan at their August meeting; the plan is posted on our website. We are able to offer our families two choices for learning this fall. One option allows for a student to learn online through lessons prepared by their teachers. The other option is much closer to a traditional schedule except for Wednesday; students will not come to school on Wednesdays and will learn at home those days. Closing the buildings on Wednesdays will allow us to focus on conducting a more thorough cleaning and provide teachers additional time to focus on the online instruction. Students will have the opportunity to take the same classes that they would during past years. Our plan provides the opportunity for students to experience a rather traditional feeling year.

It was an immense undertaking to reflect on how we delivered instruction this spring and then move forward to create an entirely new plan. We had a large committee which started the process and then formed many smaller committees to address building-specific issues. I would like to thank everyone who had a role in the planning process for all of their time and energy given to this process; we could not have done it without them.

We have been able to start construction on the addition to the high school. While there have been several recent delays due to various impacts of the pandemic, we are starting to see progress. At this point, we are still hopeful that the addition will be completed prior to spring break. Things are also moving forward with the air conditioning project and we hope to send that out to bid later this month with a desire to begin installation as soon as we are able. Once we receive bids for the air conditioning project, we will be able to prioritize the remaining projects to determine which projects we will be able to complete. As is often the case, there have been added costs along the way and we will not be able to do everything that was on our original project wishlist.

However, we have the benefit of our sinking fund to help offset some of the added expenses. It is exciting to see the visible progress being made.



As we all work together to make this school year a good one, we will undoubtedly need to make adjustments along the way. Your patience and understanding has been greatly appreciated by all of us as we continue to do everything we can to offer our students the best education possible.

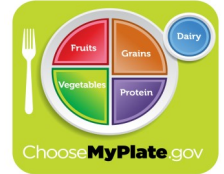

Hanover-Horton School cafeterias are meeting tough new federal nutrition standards for school meals, ensuring that meals are healthy and well-balanced and provide students all the nutrition they need to succeed at school. Now is a great time to encourage your kids to choose school lunch!

School meals offer students milk, fruits and vegetables, proteins and grains, and they must meet strict limits on saturated fat and portion size. School lunches will meet additional standards requiring:

- Age-appropriate calorie limits
- Larger servings of vegetables and fruits (students must take at least one serving of produce)
- A wider variety of vegetables, including dark green and red/orange vegetables and legumes
- Fat-free or 1% milk (flavored milk must be fat-free)
- More whole grains
- And less sodium



We're always working to offer Hanover-Horton School students healthier and tastier choices. We are focusing on serving healthy homemade entrees, locally grown foods and increased offerings of whole grains.
