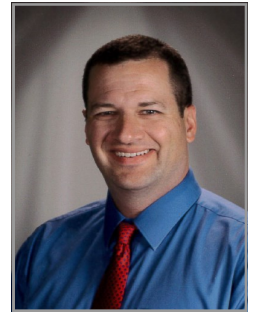
As we move into another school year, I would like to again take the opportunity

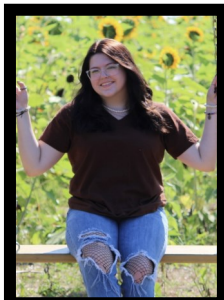

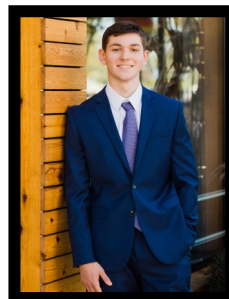
