It began with my student teaching experience, and I was very fortunate to be hired as a high school teacher the following fall. After eleven years as a social studies teacher, I moved into administrative roles. For 22 years I served as the middle school principal. I am very excited to help lead our district to continued success! We have a phenomenal teaching and support staff, school board members who are dedicated to serving the students of our district, supportive parents and an involved community, active booster groups and most importantly, amazing students! With our recently created strategic plan in place to guide us, we will work hard to provide the very best education possible for our students. Several other team members have transitioned into new positions throughout our district as well. Jeff Waltz is our new middle school principal, with Chris VanEpps stepping into his role as our new Athletic Director/Dean of Students at the secondary building. While it is always hard to say goodbye to retiring staff, we are excited to welcome five new teachers to our district. Emily Herendeen, Christopher Fowler, Hailey Schaendorf and Angel Berry will be joining the elementary staff, and Emily Schwertfeger was hired as the Senior Transitions class teacher and Virtual School coordinator at the high school. Our custodial and maintenance depart-

ments have been working hard all summer to get our buildings in tip top shape for our students' return on August 21st. Highlights include carpeting being replaced in some classrooms at the elementary and high school; the high school hallways were spruced up with new door and trim paint; and a fairly major drainage project is being completed around the middle school, as well as sidewalk replacement in front of the building. Additional sidewalk repair at the main complex will be completed in the future.

It was a pleasure to host the first of several "Comet Community Coffee" sessions at the end of July. Please watch for other opportunities to join board members, administrators and myself for casual conversation about our district. Your ideas and suggestions are always welcome.

This report is critical in determining if your family will receive Summer EBT, along with the amount of money that our school receives from a variety of State and Federal supplemental programs, like Title I A, At-risk (31a), Title II A, E-Rate, etc. Please submit this information online at: <https://hanoverhorton.familyportal.cloud/>. It is easy and quick to complete!

These supplemental programs have the potential to offer support and services for our students, including, but not limited to:

- Instructional support (staff, supplies & materials, etc.)

- Parent and community engagement supplies and activities
- Technology
