While it is always hard to say goodbye to retiring staff, we are excited to welcome five new teachers to our district. Emily Herendeen, Christopher Fowler, Hailey Schaendorf and Angel Berry will be joining the elementary staff, and Emily Schwertfeger was hired as the Senior Transitions class teacher and Virtual School coordinator at the high school. Our custodial and maintenance departments have been working hard all summer to get our buildings in tip top shape for our students' return on August 21st. Highlights include carpeting being replaced in some classrooms at the elementary and high school; the high school hallways were spruced up with new door and trim paint; and a fairly major drainage project is being completed around the middle school, as well as sidewalk replacement in front of the building. Additional sidewalk repair at the main complex will be completed in the future.

It was a pleasure to host the first of several "Comet Community Coffee" sessions at the end of July. Please watch for other opportunities to join board members, administrators and myself for casual conversation about our district. Your ideas and suggestions are always welcome.


